What type of Performer are you? In the State of Hawaii there are 3 Performer license types:



Religious Performers

- Any ordained member of an organized church or religious organization.
- Any person authorized by the church to perform marriage/union (ie. Letter of Authorization from the Church, Ordination Certificate)
- If you choose to perform Marriage and/or Civil Union, either one is considered a "religious" ceremony as your License dictates its categorization
- Citation see Hawaii Revised Statute 572-12





Non-Religious Performers

- Any person wishing to perform/officiate a Non-Religious Wedding or Civil Union
- ▶ If you choose to perform Marriage and/or Civil Union, either one is considered "Civil" for the ceremony type; your License dictates its categorization
- Citation see Hawaii Revised Statute 572-12

Judge Performers/Officiants

- Any Judge that has presided over a Hawaii Court active or retired.
- □ This includes any active or retired Federal Judges of the 9th district court which has jurisdiction in Hawaii
- ☐ If you choose to perform Marriage and/or Civil Union, either one is considered "Civil" for the ceremony type; your License dictates its categorization
- □ Citation see Hawaii Revised Statute 572-12

Welcome to the Hawaii Department of Health online Marriage and Civil Union Registration System. This online system provides a variety of services including: marriage or civil union license application with status check; marriage and/or civil union performer registration and access; and certificate validation by the government agency users. Prospective users are encouraged to review the following hints and the **instructional video** for using the system.

Couples:

- Prior to completing the marriage or civil union application, be sure to review the marriage or civil union requirements for obtaining a license;
- It's highly recommended that couples complete the online application with payment by credit card **before** meeting with an agent. Both the prospective spouses or prospective partners must appear together in person before a license agent to obtain a marriage or civil union license. Please note that your online application will be available for the issuance of a marriage or civil union license by an agent in the State of Hawaii up to one year from the application date. After a year, your application will be removed from the system. There will be no refunds for unused applications;

Performers:

- All prospective new marriage and civil union performers are required to register online. Username and password will be emailed to the provided email address upon completion of the registration;
- Any performer who has been commissioned by the State of Hawaii prior to 2012 and is interested in also performing civil union is required to apply online with indication of
 performing both civil union and marriage. Be sure to include the existing commission number to avoid unnecessary commission number creation and conflicts; and
- · Performers must complete the ceremony information and certify electronically so that couples will be able to access their electronic temporary marriage/civil union certificates

Introduction

All marriage and civil union performers must be licensed by the State of Hawaii before performing a marriage or a civil union. This website will help provide you with the information needed to be licensed as a marriage and/or civil union performer.

A \$10.00 portal administration fee will be collected online upon completion of your application. Payment will be accepted with a major credit card. Your application will be submitted for review. Upon approval, you will receive an email notification along with your approved license number and an electronic copy of your certificate. Please register at least two weeks prior to the ceremony date, as your registration could take up to two weeks for approval. There are no refunds after registering online.

There are four types of marriage and/or civil union performers in the State of Hawaii. Please click a link below for more information:

1. Religious

Religious Marriage Performer

Minister, priest, or officer of any religious denomination or society who has been ordained or is authorized to solemnize marriages according to the usages of such denomination or society, or any religious society not having clergy but providing solemnization in accordance with the rules and customs of that society (HRS §572-12)

Religious Civil Union Performer

Any ordained or licensed member of the clergy (Act 1, section -4(b), Session Laws 2011)

2. Judge

Judge for Marriage Performer

Any justice, judge or magistrate, active or retired, of a state or federal court in the State (HRS §572-12).

Judge for Civil Union Performer

Any judge or retired judge, including a federal judge or judge from another state who may legally join persons in chapter 572 or a civil union, (Act 1, section -4(b), Session Laws 2011)

3. Non Religious

Civil License for Marriage Performer

Any individual at least eighteen years of age (HRS §572-12)

Choose which type of performer you qualify under

- Religious
- Judge
- Non Religious

Choose what type(s) of legal unionization you wish to perform.

- Marriages
- Civil Unions
- (You have the option to choose either or both, after checking the boxes, there will be additional checkmarks for confirmation and compliance)

Each type bestows different rights and responsibilities. We at the Dept. of Health cannot advise what these are, it is best if they are unsure, that the couple seek legal advice what the differences are before they apply for their Marriage or Civil Union License.

Confirmation

- There will be a page after you hit the continue
- You will have the option to choose the duration of your license. (1-Year License or 60-Day License)
- All will have a final prompt confirming by entering your name and checking the box.
- It will then direct you to the E-Hawaii fee payment processing website.



Performer / Officiant License Approval

- Payment on E-Hawaii is separate from the approvement process of your license. Your payment confirmation from E-Hawaii is only for the payment NOT the approval of your performer license.
- If you are automatically approved, you will receive an automated email from emrs@ehawaii.gov
- Please check your junk/trash/spam folder for this automated email that has instructions and your login credentials. Please also check if your email browser you are using bunches up
- Otherwise your performer license application may be under review with our office, do not perform any marriages or civil unions until your license has been approved.
